Judge Brett Kavanaugh Puts Rights of Working People at Serious Risk

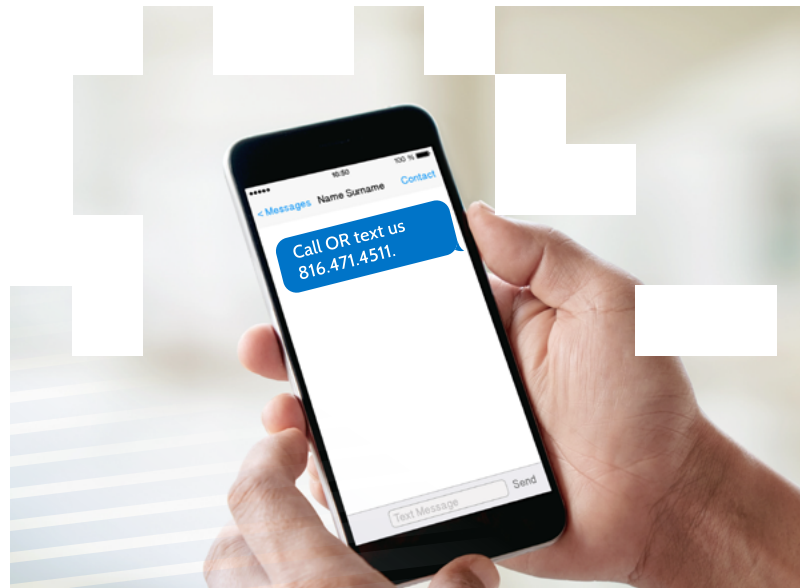
Partial statement by AFL-CIO President Richard Trumka on the nomination of Judge Brett Kavanaugh to the Supreme Court of the United States:

Favorable Decision for Family of Fallen First Responder

In a case of first impression, partner J.R. Boyd recently obtained a favorable decision benefiting a firefighter's widow by reversing a lower court outcome. In that case, the firefighter died from cancer. J.R. and Jason Iezzi, associate attorney, successfully argued that the career of workplace exposures to smoke and gases faced by a firefighter increased the risk of contracting cancer. That explanation was persuasive, and if it withstands further appeal, will provide much needed security for the family of the fallen first responder.
